

Schools are allocated a sum of money called the Primary PE and Sport Funding to support all children and improve the quality, quantity and breadth of PE and Sport Provision.

This is calculated according to the intake of the school and the school must decide how best to use the money to improve the breadth and quality of PE and Sport provision.

Our indicative Primary PE and Sport Funding for 2018 – 2019 is £16,481.00

At Treales we have decided to use this money to:

- Procure quality assured professional training for staff to raise confidence and competence in teaching PE and Sport.
- Buy into the 'Wyre and Fylde School Sports Partnership'
- Develop links with other PE teachers in local primary schools
- Provide additional extra-curricular activities through the 'Wyre and Fylde School Sports Partnership' and 'Streetwise' at no cost to pupils
- Provide transport to competitions to increase involvement for all groups of children
- Participate in competitions organised by the School Sports Partnership
- Provide opportunities both in and outside school for all pupils to engage in sport

- Purchase additional resources and equipment
