Dear Parents, Carers and Children,

It has been a strange week to begin our school year. The new school year always marks a period of change and new starts but this has never been reflected the national news as it has this year.

We marked the announcement of Queen Elizabeth II's death in school this morning with a special worship to think about the life of the Queen and her service. As the church bells rang over lunchtime, we sat in quiet reflection as well as two Year 6 children helping to ring the bell. The children have spoken about how we will reflect the period of national mourning. The area under the oak tree will be used as a space for reflection. Children and families are welcome to leave any messages, prayers or flowers and these will be left until the morning after the Queen's funeral.

Treales Praise on Sunday will be replaced with a special Morning Prayer service. Whilst children and families are always welcome in church, this service will not be youth orientated.

Worship

Worship will be held from 3pm everyday.

On Mondays this worship will take place in church. Parents are welcome to join us for this act of worship. Children will be dismissed from church at 3.30pm, starting with the youngest children. If you are collecting children but not attending worship, we ask that you wait inside the school gate under the Oak tree so that children can be safely dismissed

On Fridays we will be holding Celebration worship in the school hall. Parents again are welcome to join us for this celebration of our week. Please arrive via the main entrance. Depending on the number of parents, this may be a squash and a squeeze!
