#### **Harvest Festival**

We would like to invite all to attend our Harvest Treales Praise at 11am and welcome you to stay for lunch following the service (A Jacob's Join). The children will be singing a Harvest Song and reading prayers they have written in R.E. If you would like to bring tins of canned food or toiletries to donate to those in our community in need, all donations would be gratefully received. As this is also Rev Christine's last service we have been asked to help ring the church bell at 10.50am before the service. If your child would like to ring the bell to celebrate all Rev Christine's work, Mrs Hill will meet you in church at 10.50am.

#### Grounds at the back of school

The play areas at the back of school where children enter and are collected from are in a poor condition. We ask that children do not play on these areas at the beginning or end of the school day. Further inspections on the equipment and trees have be scheduled and plans to develop this area so that it can be fully utilised by the children are in the early stages.

#### Snacks at Break Time

At break time children in Oak class (Reception and KS1) have milk and fruit. Fruit is provided universally for all children until the end of Year 2. Milk is provided until your child's 5<sup>th</sup> birthday.

Children in KS2 (Willow and Elder Class) can bring in a **healthy** snack to eat at break time. This could be a piece of fruit, vegetables such as carrots or cucumber, fruity or plain breakfast bar. We ask that chocolate products and crisps are not given as a snack and are kept to lunchboxes only.

#### Primary and Secondary Places for September 2023

#### Primary

You must apply if your child has a 4th birthday between 1 September 2022 and 31 August 2023. The closing date is 15th January 2022.

#### Secondary

You must apply if your child is in their last year of primary school (year 6) from September 2022. The closing date is 31st October 2022. You must apply even if an older brother or sister is already at the school.

**Autumn cleanup** of the school grounds on **Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> October** between 10am-2pm. Any help would be much appreciated!


We also have an exciting opportunity to join our **100 club**. Details will be coming home this weekend with information on how the draw works, and how to join.
