Dear Parents, Carers and Children,

We have come to the end of this half term, thank you for the warm welcome. It has been lovely to get to know you. Thank you for sharing your views through the questionnaires and in conversation. Please be aware all children who have hair that is shoulder length or longer or a long fringe that goes into their eyes, must wear a swimming cap. These can be any colour except red. They can be purchased at St Annes pool. Girls must wear a one piece costume and boys tight fitting trunks or short. No baggy clothing or shorts longer than the knee are allowed. These are rules that are set by the school swimming teachers not Treales CE Primary School.

Secondary

You must apply if your child is in their last year of primary school (year 6) from September 2022. The closing date is **31st October 2022.** You must apply even if an older brother or sister is already at the school.

Primary

You must apply if your child has a 4th birthday between 1 September 2022 and 31 August 2023. The closing date is 15th January 2022.


Any children coming to the Light Party don't forget a jar, and if you want your pumpkin judging bring that along too!


