Dear Parents, Carers and Children,

Christmas and the end of term is quickly approaching! I am pleased to be able to update you regarding staffing in school for the New Year and important dates for the rest of term.

We would like to invite you all to a special worship on Monday 12th December at 3pm in church to say thank you to Mrs Mather for her service to Treales CE Primary School over the last 12 years. Children and staff will be leading this very special worship.

Whilst we are still recruiting a permanent member of our teaching team, classes will be taught in January 2023 by:

Oak Class (EYFS/KS1): Mrs Hill, Mrs Cameron, Mrs Smith and Mrs Molyneux

Willow Class (LKS2): Mrs Rose and Mrs James Elder Class (UPK2): Mrs Winn and Mrs James

Mrs James is joining us for the spring term. She is a very experienced teacher and will be teaching across school. Mrs James will be in school on Friday 2nd and 9th December in the morning to get to know staff and children before the Christmas break. We are also welcoming our new welfare staff, Mrs Wells and Miss Suffolk to school on Monday 28th November. I am sure you will offer them all a warm welcome to our Treales family.

Mrs Mather will be running Parents' evening for Oak class only on Monday 5th December and Wednesday 7th December from 2pm-5.30pm. This will be an opportunity for Mrs Mather to update parents on progress and attainment before she leaves. Appointment slots will be sent out early next week. This will replace the parents evening in January for Oak Class. Parents' Evening for Willow and Elder class will be held as planned on 30th January 2023.

Please could we politely ask all parents and carers who attend worship on Monday or Friday leave children in the care of school staff. Children enjoy waving and smiling to their adults and this is enough to reassure them of your presence. Children should remain with school staff until they are officially handed over at the end of the school day. To help staff safely account for all children, we will be asking parents and carers to leave church and the school hall before the children are dismissed. Thank you for helping us continue to safeguard all our children in school.

We have been fortunate for our Key Stage 2 children to be able to visit Kirkham Grammar School to hear 'Supervet' Noel Fitzpatrick and for Year 3 and 4 to watch KGS production of Peter Pan. The children's behaviour was excellent and both events were enjoyed by all. Next week Year 5 and 6 are attending our first sports fixture of the year, Sportshall Athletics at Carr Hill, competing against other local schools. On Thursday Oak class are visiting Judge's Lodgings to experience a Victorian Christmas. Victorian dressing up is optional for this trip. We are all looking forward to visiting The Grand Theatre to watch Sleeping Beauty pantomime on 8th December. A big thank you to the PTFA for continuing to support school so that we can offer these enhancements to our curriculum.

On 7th December Coram LIfe Education will be visiting school to deliver puberty sessions to Years 4,5 and 6 and Cyber Safety to Years 3,4,5 and 6. Further information about these sessions and parent information sessions will be sent via ParentApp. These sessions cover compulsory parts of the PSHE and Computing curriculum.

We are busy practising the Nativity in school. The singing is sounding amazing and I am loving seeing the children practising their lines and dances on the playground. We will be filming a dress rehearsal and the link to this will be shared with you for a limited time to watch over the Christmas holiday. Consent for your child to appear in this recording has been added to the ParentApp for you to complete. The PTFA will be selling photographs at the Christmas Fair. So that both a recording and photographs are possible, please ensure your child has their costume in school by Friday 2nd December. A note regarding your child's costume has been sent home today.

On Thursday 15th December we will be supporting Brian House Children's Hospice through completing the Christmas Elf Run in school. Further information will be sent nearer the event.


