Welcome to the summer term! Hopefully the weather will continue to warm up and children can enjoy this busy term.

Summer uniform can be worn now – blue summer dresses, grey shorts, white polo shirts and the usual school jumper or cardigan. Please can we remind you that on PE days children MUST wear the school hoody or new tracksuit top or a plain navy or black top. Plain black or blue shorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms must be worn with white polo shirts or t shirts. Jewellery is not allowed in school except for one plain pair of stud earrings and a simple watch. Children will be reminded of the correct uniform as necessary.

Please can we also ask parents to support us by not allowing children to bring toys or items from home into school (including breakfast and after school club) unless they have been asked to by the class teacher. Items brought from home can cause conflict with other children and there is always a danger that these items go missing or get damaged.

This term will be VERY busy! Children have returned to school and continued to work hard towards their end of year expectations. Year 6 are showing super maturity in their preparation for SATS and we all wish them every success. Year 2 will be completing their SATS, Year 1 the phonics screening and Year 4 the multiplication check, over the coming weeks. If you have any questions about these statutory assessments, please see your child's class teacher. Children will be preparing in school and will be well practiced in the tasks. Any support you can offer will be communicated on homework sheets. It is important that this work is completed.

We are excited to welcome you to school on Friday 5th May to celebrate the King's Coronation. Celebration worship will be at the earlier time of 1.30pm followed by family activities and refreshments themed to the coronation. At 3.15pm we will be marking the occasion by planting trees during a short worship outside (weather permitting). There is a cake competition for all children to take part in. Please send your coronation themed baked goods into school for judging by 9.30am on Friday 5th May. Winners will be announced in Celebration worship and prizes presented on Sunday 7th May during 'A Right Royal Knees Up Big Lunch'. Cakes will be available to buy as refreshment during the afternoon.

Mrs Hill met with the Kirkham Club Day committee last week to agree how Christ Church Treales and Treales CE Primary can be involved in club day. It has been agreed we will walk in the procession and invite all to join us in representing the church and school. As we do not have an incumbent vicar and this is the first time in a number of years we have joined in, we are going to keep things as simple as possible. We invite all children (and families) to design the front of our club day t-shirt. The winning three designs will be printed onto the front of t-shirts for all to buy and wear in the procession. Designs must be as colourful as possible – use A4 paper and felt tip or paint. As Kirkham Club Day is church driven (unlike other club days that involve all community groups), we are asking for designs to represent one or all of our Christian values: Truth, Justice, Community, Courage, Peace and Love. All designs must be handed in to Mrs Hill by Friday 12th May. for Year 5 and 6 races from 2.30pm.

We must say a big thank you to Friends of Treales for submitting a application to the Edith Mary Clark Foundation for money towards Oak class's new flooring. This has already enabled Oak class children to access more art and messy activities to support their learning. We are sure you have all noticed the wonderful new grass on the area where the ship once stood. The children have enjoyed using this for worship, class discussions, phonics lessons and much more.

The calendar will also appear on your School Spider app. All information about each event is added to these entries so you have all the information in one place. Lots of trips and visitors to school in the coming weeks.

Year 6 children who are transitioning to Carr Hill High School may have noticed that the transition day and our sports day clash. I have spoken to Mr Penny who has informed me that the afternoon will finish at 2.15pm so that children can come back to school for Year 5 and 6 races from 2.30pm.
